



Notes about GRIDLOCK crosswords:

- * The clues will be listed in numbered groups, each clue showing its letter count as usual.
- * Answers to a group of clues will be entered into the ring with that number, each word both starting and finishing at triangle cells.
- * There is no indication of whether each word runs clockwise or anticlockwise: this must be deduced.
- * There is no indication of which triangle each word starts in: this must be deduced.

If this sounds hard, bear in mind that the endpoints are shared: each is either the first or last letter of each of two answers in a group. This will really help in figuring out how the answers in a ring chain together. Also, because rings share three contiguous cells with each adjacent ring, this should make it possible to deduce where each word goes, by examining the letters in each ring.
