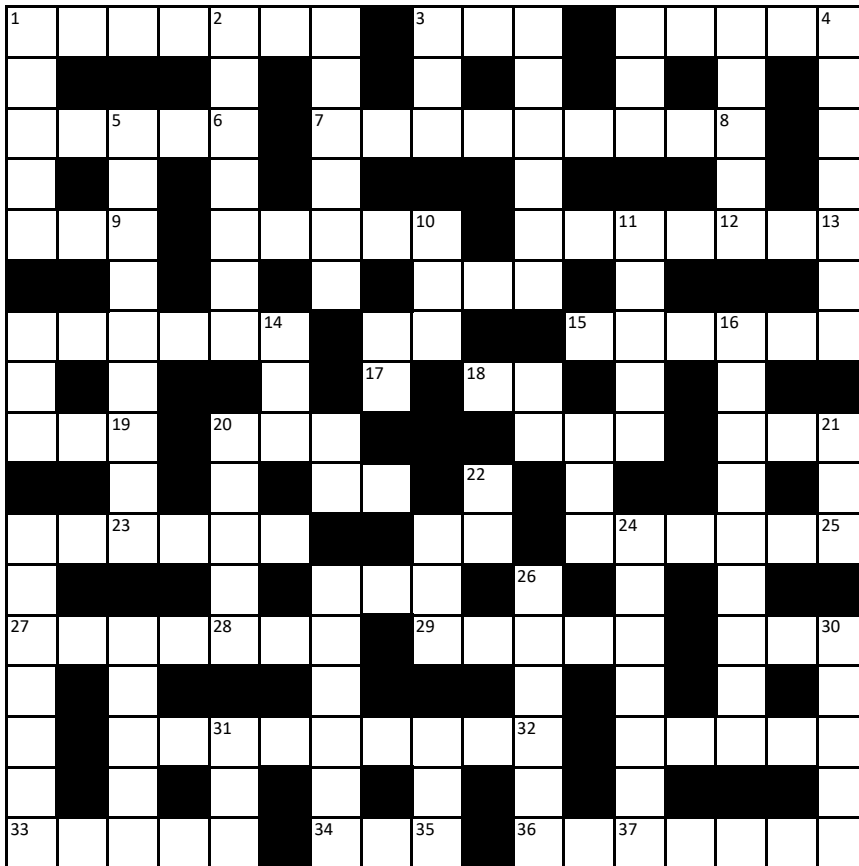


Meander 2026-08-17 by TORUS



Notes about "meandering" crosswords:

- * Each answer begins at the cell with its clue number, then meanders through the grid. Some numbered cells are the start of multiple words.
- * The start and end of a word are cells without other cells before or after them, i.e. words never begin or end in the middle of a "standard slot" - unless it's a T junction, where they must use the "minor road".
- * Answers never re-use their own cells, but they may share cells with other answers - and not just at intersections: this can happen along entire sub-paths of cells.
